For example:

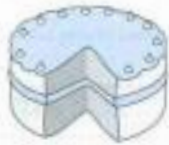
The spotty puppy ran across the field.

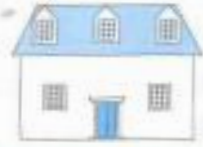
