1. A cinema has 21 screens. Each screen has 297 seats. How many seats are there in the cinema?
2. Eggs are sold in trays of 24. In a week, a farmer sells 372 trays. How many eggs does he sell in one week?
3. A bag of nails contains 613 nails. A hardware store has 23 bags. How many nails are in the 23 bags?
4. There are 27 children in a class. Each child pays £7.49 for a school trip. How much do they pay altogether?
5. A football club has an average attendance of 859 people to each match. What is the total attendance for the 29 matches played in a season?
