THE UK

The UK Government believes that developing carbon capture and storage (CCS) technology is really important for the future. CCS involves collecting the carbon dioxide produced by factories and power plants and storing it underground so it doesn't get into the atmosphere.

The UK is also using more **renewable energy** than ever, like wind power.



COSTA RICA

Costa Rica aims to stop adding to the greenhouse gases in the atmosphere in the next few years.

The country has almost completely stopped burning fossil fuels to generate electricity.

Instead, they use cleaner, renewable energy such as **hydroelectricity** (electricity generated by moving water).
