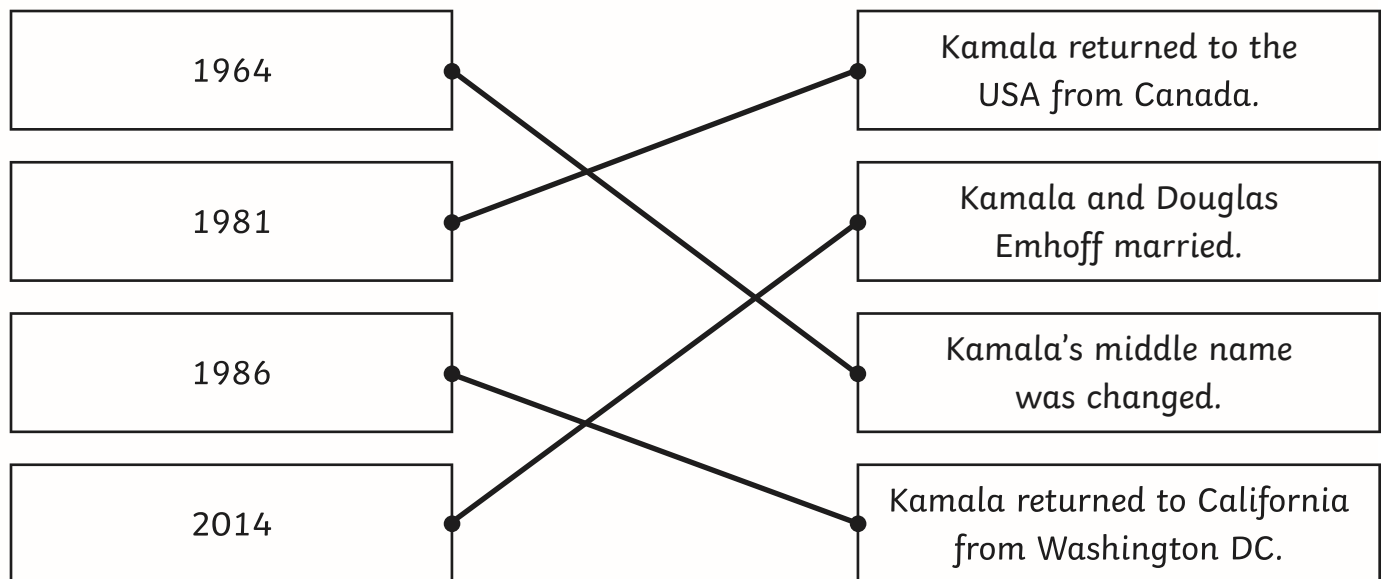

7. Summarise how Kamala could be elected as vice-president of the USA in 25 words or fewer.

Pupils' own responses, such as: Kamala could be elected as vice-president because she was the 'running mate' of Joe Biden, who is projected to win the presidential election.

8. Compare **two** jobs that Kamala has had and explain why they are similar.

Pupils' own responses, such as: Kamala's jobs as deputy district attorney and as California's Attorney General were similar because they both helped people in California and they were both jobs in which she made sure that the laws of California were upheld and applied fairly.

9. 'Kamala promotes equality.'

Give **two** ways that the text supports this statement.

Pupils' own responses, such as: I know that this statement is true because the text says that she defended the legal rights of refugees and immigrants and that she helped to secure marriage equality for all Californians. Both of these things show that Kamala believes that everyone should be equal in the eyes of the law.

10. Compare how Kamala's university studies are similar to her father's university teaching career.

Pupils' own responses, such as: Kamala studied economics at Howard University and her father, Donald, teaches economics as a professor at a university. This means that they must both really understand economics.
