

The Values Game

How to play this game:

- 1 You will need a board and a set of cards, and it works well if you play the game in a group of four.
- 2 Put the cards in pile, face downwards. Play in turns around the group.

When it's your turn, you must do three things:

 - Read out the top card
 - Ask the other players where on the board they would put the card, and why.
 - Ignore them, and put it where you think it goes for you. Give your reasons to the group.
- 3 When it's your turn, if you want to, you can also move another person's card to a space that you choose. 'Move one, place one' is the rule. It's important to give your reasons, and to negotiate if the space you want is already taken with another card.
- 4 All cards must be in one space only – no overlapping is allowed.
- 5 When all the cards are out, play three more rounds in which you just swap two cards over. Give your reasons.
