2- Uplevelling sentences:

Uplevel this sentence in your English book by adding an **expanded noun phrase** and a **second main clause** (don't forget to add today's date and a title)

Simba's elephant was refusing to go anywhere today.

(Hint- an expanded noun phrase adds detail about the noun and in this sentence, it would be the elephant, the second main clause will start with a co-ordinating conjunction -FANBOYS- or will use a semi-colon)

3- The Last Wild by Piers Torday-

We are going to start looking at **chapter one** today. Hopefully you heard me reading some of this yesterday afternoon.

- **Read** the text, with an adult if you can
- **Write** a new title in your English book-
'The Last Wild, Chapter One'
- Look at the **activity** sheet in the English folder the words in the **'words discussed'** section- **find** each word in the text, then **write** each word in your English book
write a definition of its meaning- make sure you *understand* the definition
- Now **complete the rest of the activities** on the sheet- writing three sentences for the words given and matching the definitions.

Please write **neatly and carefully**- think about your **handwriting, punctuation and spelling**.
