### Online safety

- 2- Work through the **powerpoint** in the folder and answer the questions verbally as they come up. **Stop on slide 8** and do the **activity** 'Chatting online: Personal Information quiz sheet' from the folder-

*What **images or layout** would help them remember your advice?*

*Can you think of a slogan or saying that they could easily remember to help them know what to do?*
