You should already have your **daily dictation** in your English book for today and a date underlined.

1- Complete the **IDENTITY spelling mat** and stick it in your English book. Don't worry if you can't print it out- just do the activities straight in to your English book.

2- Upleveling sentences:

Uplevel this sentence in your English book by adding a **fronted adverbial** and an **embedded clause** (don't forget to add today's date and a title) – I believe there should be three commas- do you have them all?

The real identity of the hero was kept hidden until now.

(Hint- a fronted adverbial is followed by a comma and an embedded clause sits in between two commas. The embedded clause in this sentence could come after the word hero to tell us more about the hero.)

3- **New Year's Resolutions:** Look in the folder for the **New Years' Resolutions 1 sheets**- read the first sheet and complete the second sheet. If you can't print it out, that's ok, you can just re-create your own version. Share your completed sheet with a family member and stick it into your English book.

Please write **neatly and carefully**- think about your **handwriting, punctuation and spelling**.

Now look at the sheet **entitled 'Ten things I want to do in the new year'**- again, this doesn't need to be printed, instead you can do it on plain paper or write straight in to your English book. I know it can be difficult this year to think positively, but I want to encourage you to be imaginative and creative despite any restrictions we may have ahead of us.

Message- Try and complete all tasks within the hour, but if you are running out of time, perhaps you could finish your ten things later on.
