

Class 5 Maths

Thursday 7th January

Co-ordinates Y5 and 6

Spend **an hour** on maths today please- as we would in class normally

1- Look in the maths folder at the **Helicopter Coordinates** sheet and follow the instructions to practice using co-ordinates in all four quadrants. There are two posters to remind you of how to plot or write co-ordinates in the folder too if you need them. If you can't print out the sheet, then create your own grid in your maths book. You should have created a helicopter shape if you have plotted the points correctly!

2- Draw a **new grid** in your maths book and label it carefully. Draw a **picture** on your grid with a ruler using obvious points to plot co-ordinates. On a separate page, **clearly record the co-ordinates** of all the points in order that they join up (as shown on the helicopter sheet).

(When you send me photos of your work later, I will choose a few to send to the class for next week to see if they create the same picture as you from your co-ordinates!)

Message: If you are finding co-ordinates tricky- **take your time and work carefully and slowly**- I would rather you do the first task well and with understanding than rush through both tasks. If you don't have time within the hour to do both tasks then do not worry.

Further practice or instead of task 2: have a look at **Education City Y6- geometry- Return of the Quack**
