Consonants Say the pure sounds (do not add 'uh').

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Each box contains one sound but sometimes more than one grapheme. Focus graphemes are *circled*.

Green words

Read in Fred Talk (sounds).

is in full mud has got truck back
lost cap hut left pit

Read the root word first and then with the ending.

tip → tips

Red words

the of to no my

Vocabulary check

Discuss the meaning (as used in the story) after the children have read each word.

definition:

tip-up truck *lorry with a container that can lift up to let the mud fall out*

pit *a hole in the ground (tip mud into a pit)*

left *forgot (I left my cap...)*

Punctuation to note in this story:

Dan Ken *Capital letters for names*

Yes The It No *Capital letters that start sentences*

. *Full stop at the end of each sentence*

! *Exclamation mark used to show anger and surprise*

? *Question mark*

Introduction

Dan and Ken are builders. Ken is wearing his favourite baseball cap. But he takes it off for a while because he gets so hot working. Unfortunately, it is the very last time he sees it.

What do you think happens to his baseball cap?

Dan is in his tip-up truck.

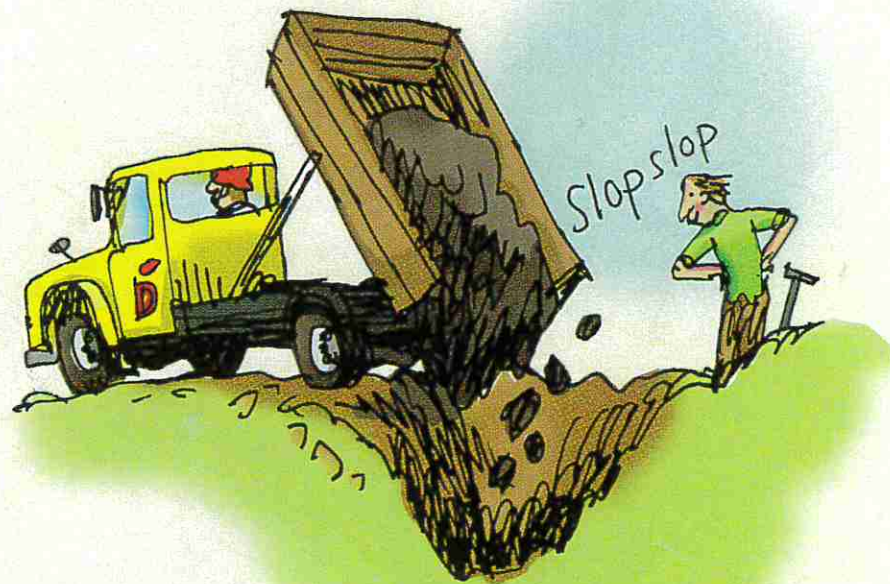
The tip-up truck is full of mud.

But Ken has lost his cap.

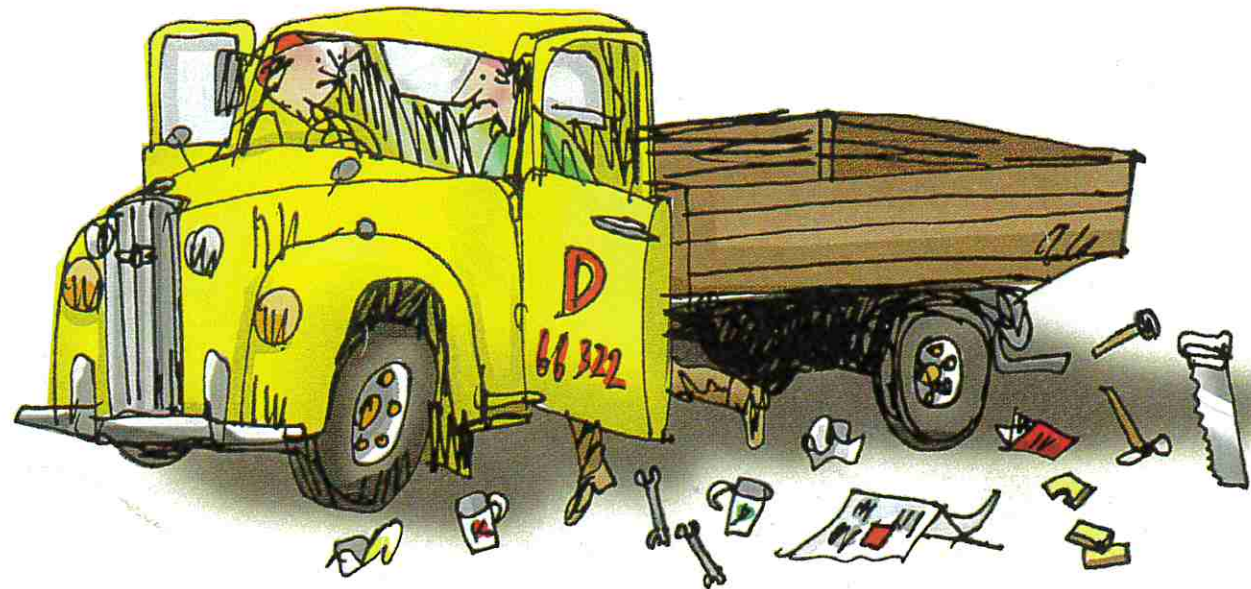
"Is it in **the** hut?"

 What does Ken feel? (fed-up, miserable, disappointed, cross?)
 What does Dan feel? (sorry, couldn't care less, thoughtful?)
