Ben, Kim, Beth and Pip, Sam and Jess have just started school. After their reading lesson, Miss Jay, their teacher, tells them what they will do.

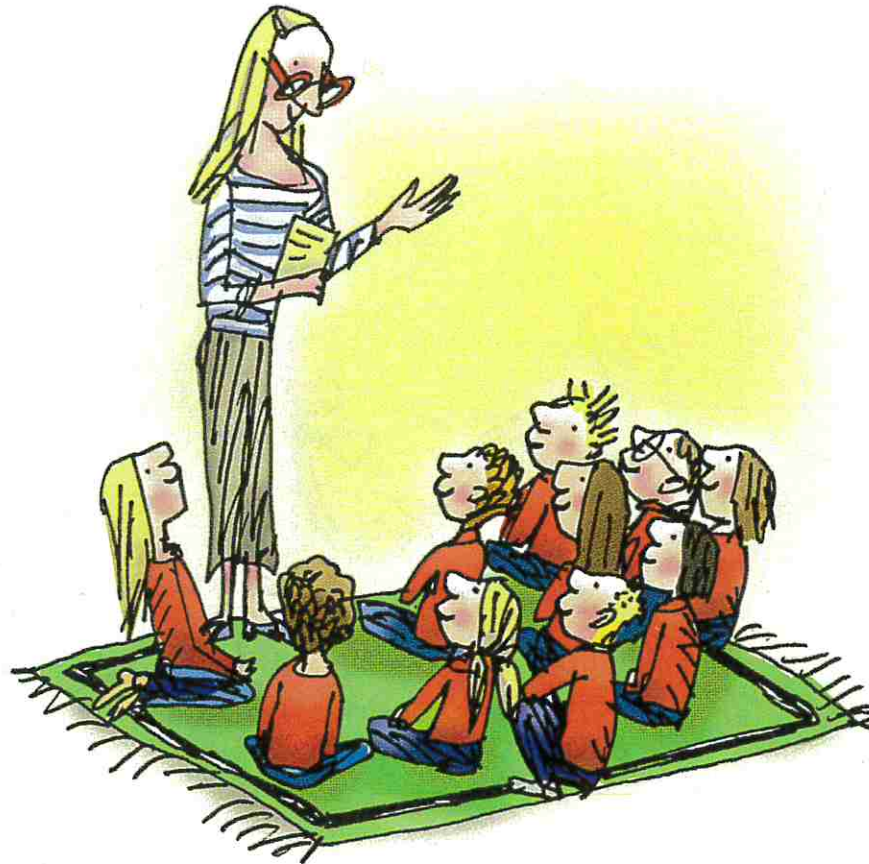
But what will Miss Jay do?
