

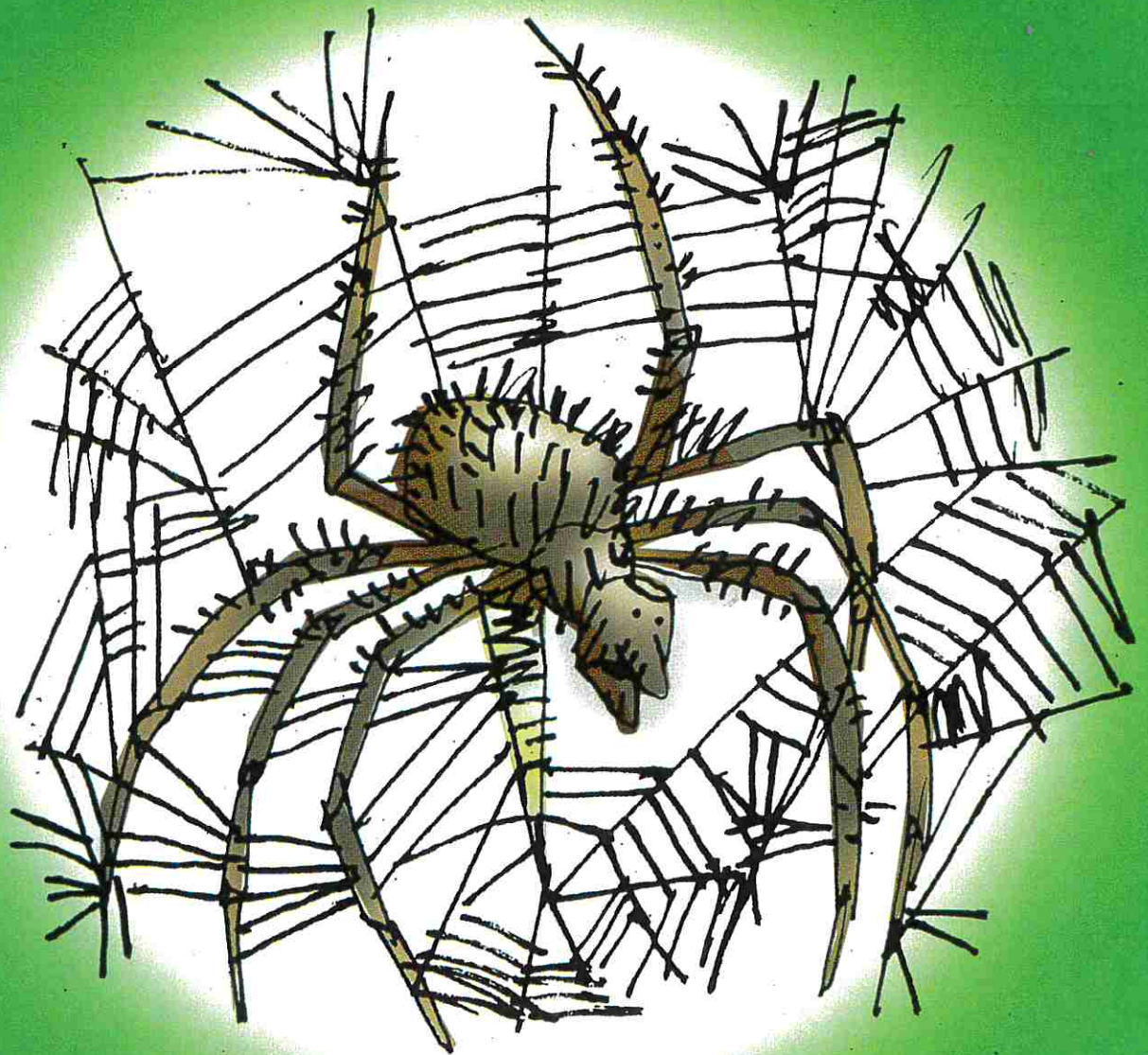

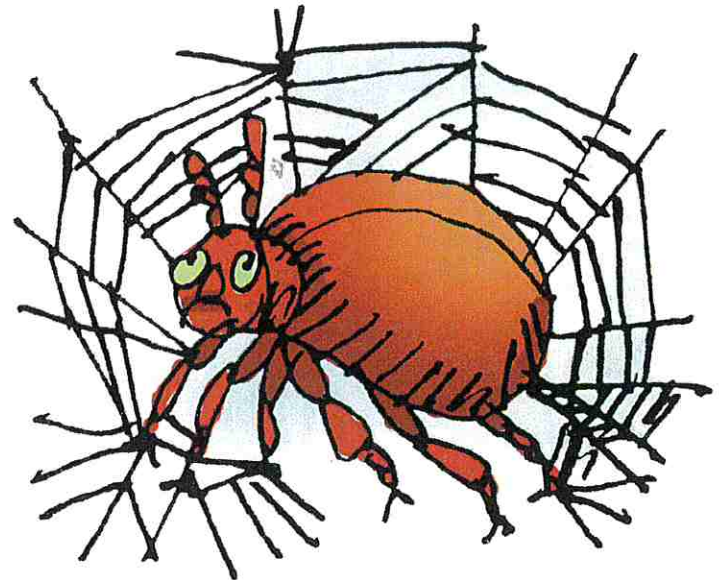

said Spin.



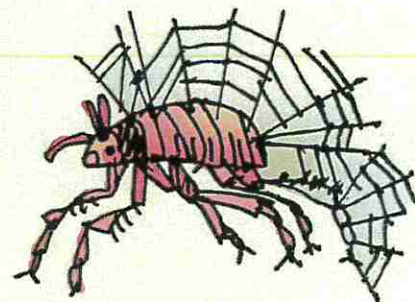
"A big black bug ...



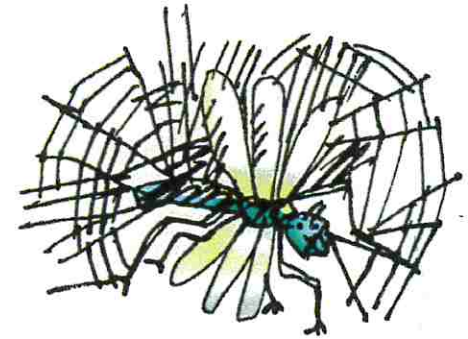
a bug with spots ...



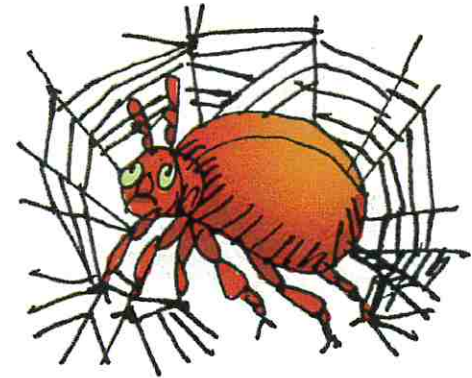
a flat pink bug ...



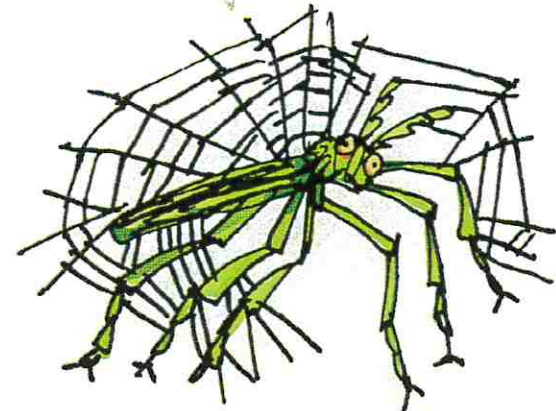
a bug with six wings ...

and a long thin bug.

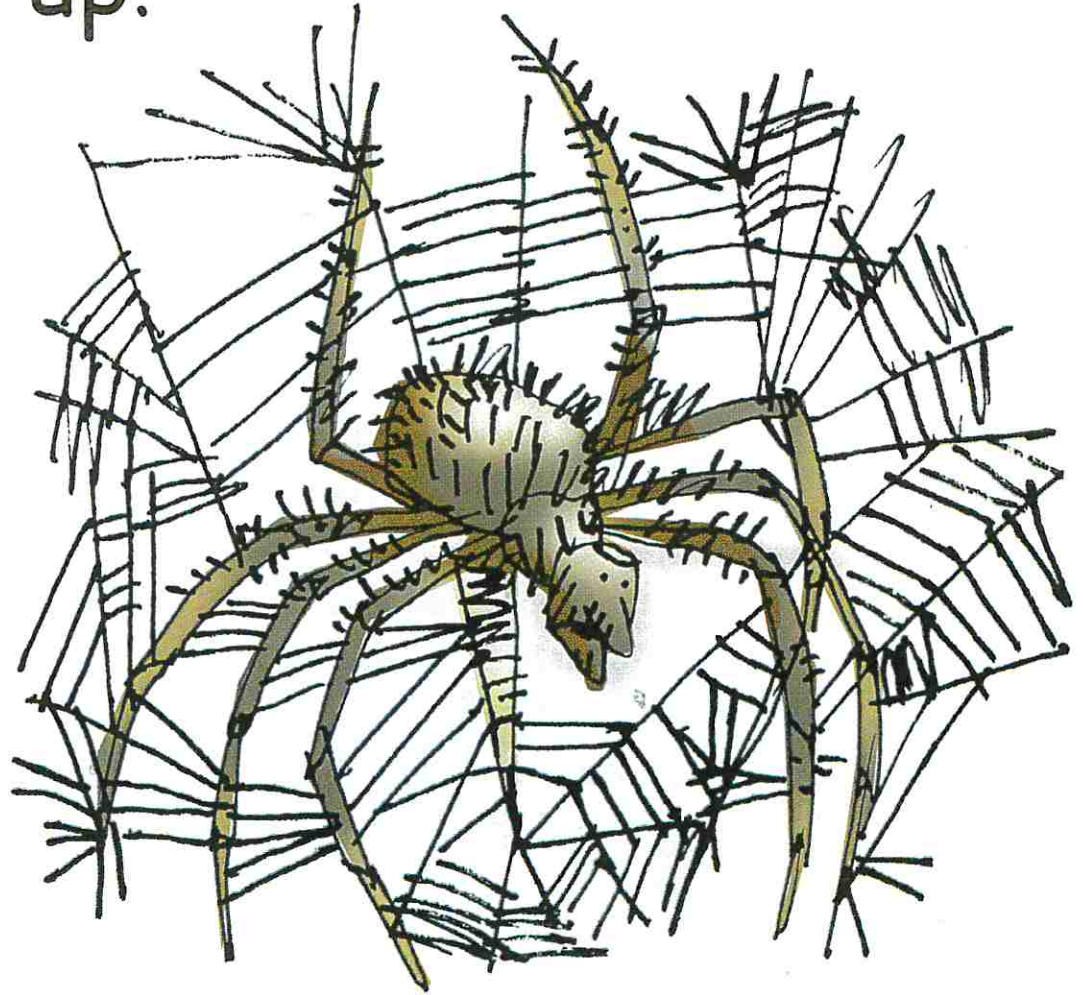


I will get the six bugs and
