Maths

Reading

This week's reading comprehension is on Chapter 1 of 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King. Read the chapter with an adult and then answer the questions.

Grammar

Complete the Year 4 SPaG mat in the English folder.

Short Writing

There is an improving sentences/completing a short story activity for each day but **these do not have to be completed every day unless you would like to.**

Topic writing

This half term our topic is the Olympics/Paralympics.

This week I would like you to write a letter to the IOC (International Olympic Committee) to persuade them to choose London as the next host for the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

You will need to think about:

- Why London would be a good place to host the Olympics.
- What London has got to offer in terms of tourism too.
- The venues that would be available.
- Remember that London hosted the games in 2012 so you could explain how successful the games were then.

In the English folder there is a planning template to help structure your arguments. In the resources folder there is an example of a persuasive letter so you can see the structure and language used, a checklist to make sure you have included all the key features and a key words and phrases mat which might be useful.

Think carefully about your audience – this will be a formal letter (no contractions or slang words please!)
