### Maths

Year 4, you are completing your final week of learning based on decimals. Follow the videos on White Rose Maths Home Learning – there are follow up tasks to complete. Miss Wills has also created a '**Super Seven Challenge**' for you this week – seven challenges with seven questions for each, focusing on what we have been learning.

## Times Table Rockstars Update

- 8 children in Class 4 completed the challenge of playing 4 Studio sessions this week.
- 7 children completed the challenge of playing 4 Garage games.
- Year 4 beat both Year 5 and Year 3 in 'Battle of the bands'.
- Year 5 beat Year 6 in 'Battle of the bands'.
- 3 of the top 5 fastest children in the school on Studio are in Class 4 (well done RJ, Seth and Harry P).
- 17 children are answering questions in under 6 seconds on Studio.
- Callum and Owen have had a competitive week, challenging each other to 8 Rock Slams since the end of April!

This week you are being challenged to play 4 Garage Games and 4 Studio games.

Year 4 will be against Year 5 and Year 3 in Battle of the Bands and Year 5 will also be against Year 6.

Some information for anyone who was not in school when we set up Time Tables Rockstars.

When you log in there will be options for you to play different games.

- **Garage:** Play games based on times tables that have been set by me. This is best for practising and earning coins.
- **Studio:** Checks how fast you can answer multiplication questions up to 12x12. This is where you earn your rock speed and status.
- **Soundcheck:** Answer 25 questions with 6 seconds per question.

## Multiplayer Options:

- **Arena:** Play other members of Class 4 who are logged in at the time.
- **Rock Slam:** Challenge someone in the school to see who can answer the most times table questions correctly? Has anyone challenged you?
