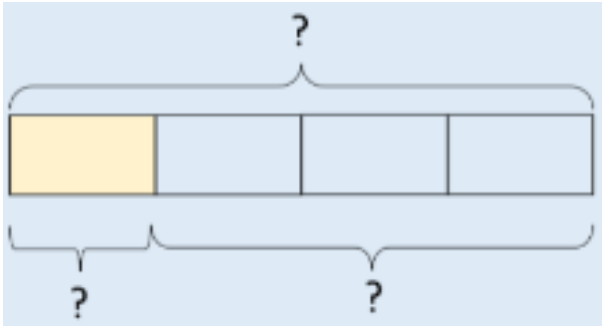


DAY FIVE
