For English this week, I would like you to write a biography about Winston Churchill. Included in this folder are resources that may be useful to you.

I have outlined a plan for the week below if you would like to follow one, however you may be happy just to research and write the biography. You may decide to start some of the following day's work early. It is up to you and what works for you and your family.

You do not need to print anything out.

Monday

Read through the '**Biography Text with Annotations**' sheet in either the Year 4 folder or Year 5 folder.

Can you create a list of features for a biography?

Use these as a success criteria and check them against the '**Features of a biography checklist**' in the folder.

Tuesday

Use the '**Biography Research Template**' (you do not need to print this out as you can do this in your book) to research information about Winston Churchill. There are questions for you to make notes about to help you.

Wednesday

Use your research from yesterday to write a biography about Winston Churchill. Remember to include a title, overview paragraph, sub headings, concluding paragraph) as well as the features you found on Monday. Use the '**Biography Word Mat**' in the Year 4 or Year 5 folder to help with key words.

Thursday

Complete your biography.

Edit (focus on capital letters, full stops and spellings).

Present it neatly with a picture of Winston Churchill.
