

## Continuous Line Creatures

Use your imagination to turn a simple continuous line drawing into a group of quirky illustrations.



### **You will need:**

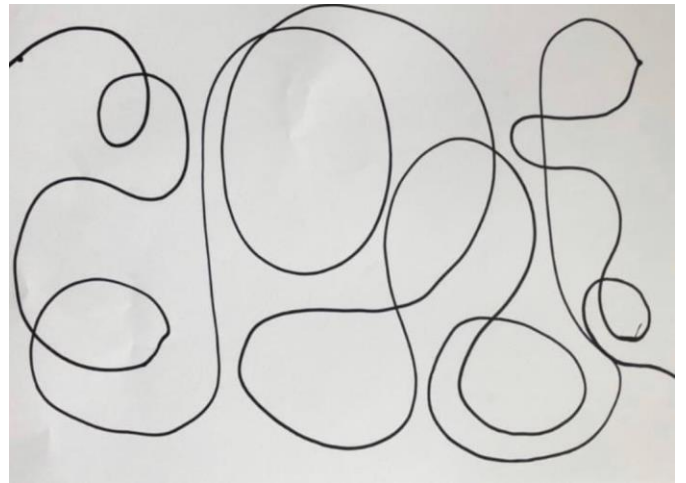
- Paper
- Pencil
- Black felt tip pen
- Colour pens/pencils

### **Step One:**

Using your black felt tip pen or pencil, start by filling your page with a continuous line squiggle drawing.

Continuous line means not taking the pen/pencil off the page until you're finished.

Take a moment to look at all the shapes your line drawing has created.



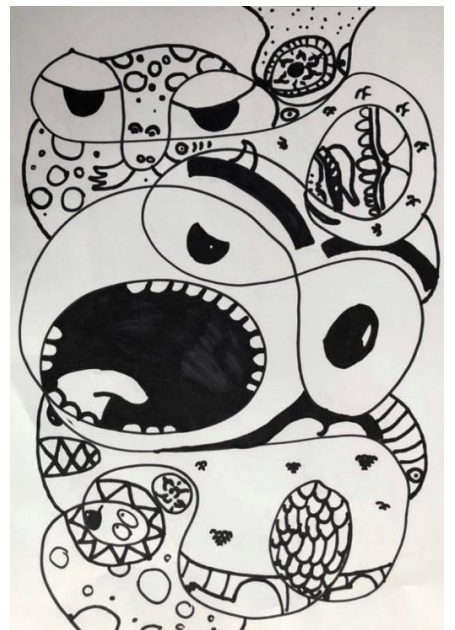
### **Step Two:**

Use a pencil (or pen if you feel confident) to add extra details to these shapes to turn them into characters. You could pick out certain shapes that remind you of animals.

Or use every available space in your drawing to add made up characters and creatures.

### **Step Four:**

Add colour.





## Texture Landscapes

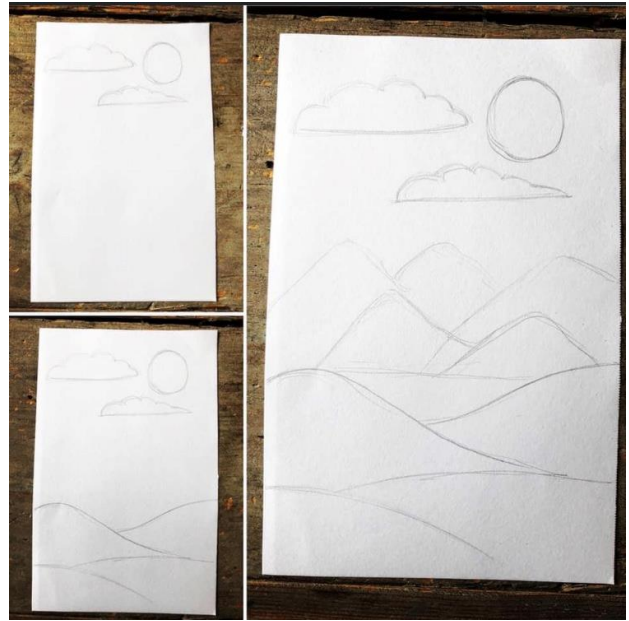
### You will need:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Felt tip pen
- Colour pencils/pens



### Step One:

Lightly sketch out a landscape. Start at the top with a sun and clouds, then add some hills at the bottom of the page and mountains in the background.



### Step Two:

Outline your drawing in black pen.

Now use coloured pencils/pens to add a line pattern to each section of the landscape.

Try to use a different colour and different line pattern for each section.

Continue until every section is filled.
