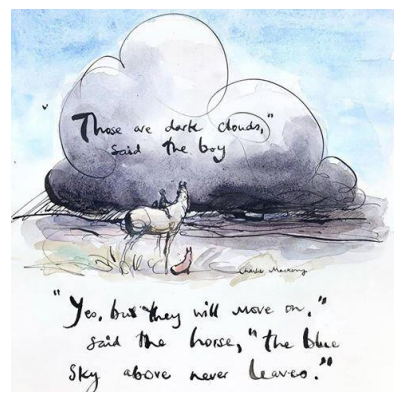


Year 5 Home Learning Overview

Maths

Look at separate sheet in Y5 Maths folder.

Reading

There are two short reading comprehensions to complete in the English folder based on 'Cogheart' by Peter Bunzl and 'The Girl of Ink and Stars' by Kiran Millwood Hargrave.

Read the extracts (to an adult if possible) and then answer the questions.

Spelling

If you're in Class 4 you could start doing this daily too.

- One writing lesson on finishing a short story using the story starter on the sheet.

Topic writing

This half term our topic is going to be the Olympics/Paralympics as these were due to be held in Tokyo this summer but have been rescheduled to next year.

This week your task is to conduct research and create a fact page (a double page of your exercise book) showing:

- Where in the world Tokyo is (draw and locate on a map)
- The country's flag
- Population of Japan and Tokyo
- Language spoken
- Climate
- Has Tokyo hosted the games before? How many times?
- What dates will the Olympics be held in 2021?
- What 33 sports will feature?
- When will the Paralympic games be held in 2021?
- What 22 sports will feature?
- Who are the mascots for the games?
