VE Day

Tuesday 8th May 1945

Dear Diary,

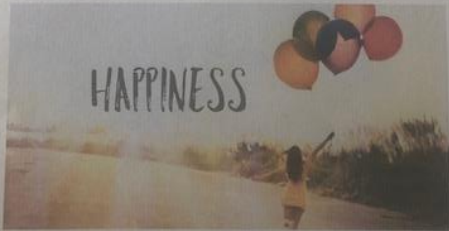


What does happiness feel like?
