## Life at Kingsland CE Primary School: life in all its fullness (John 10:10)

Being able to offer a broad, balanced and rich curriculum for all children is of paramount importance to us at Kingsland CE Primary School. This is firmly illustrated by all the activities that have occurred over the last two weeks:

- Y6 children were active participants in the World Day of Prayer service at the Methodist Church on 1<sup>st</sup> March, leading readings and representing the school within the local community.
- A number of sporting fixtures have taken place recently, with as many children as possible taking part (see the sport report below)
- The inter-house Spelling Bee took place on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March, where two representatives from each house competed against children within the same year group (see the winners list below)
- Class 3 children have now adopted their polar bear (although no-one seems to be able to say its name!) as part of discovering about the impact of plastic waste in the world's oceans. Class 2 are exploring the alternatives to the (many) small milk cartons which get used daily and how this plastic waste could be reduced. Classes 4 and 5 are working on developing new designs for cotton bags for Morrisons and writing letters to persuade them to think of alternatives to plastic bag usage. And Class 1 ... well their rocket has landed in Italy this week, and consequently I have been hearing many "Mama Mia's" being exclaimed from the classroom, as well as witnessing pizza making!
- Classes 4 and 5 visited three different places of worship in Wolverhampton on Wednesday, learning about the people, traditions and beliefs. This was a fabulous experience which the children and staff thoroughly valued.
