Thank you for supporting our campaign to keep children safe by avoiding parking on the yellow zig zag lines outside school. Please continue to use the Coronation Hall car park instead.



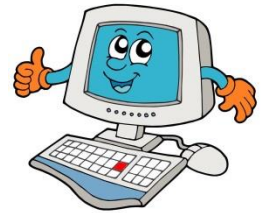
