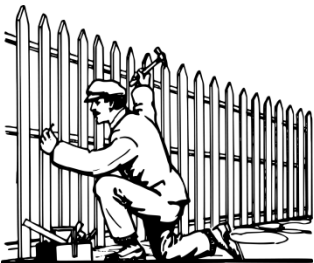


Coffee morning
