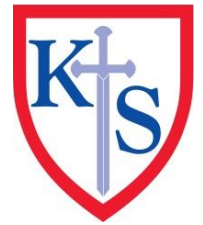

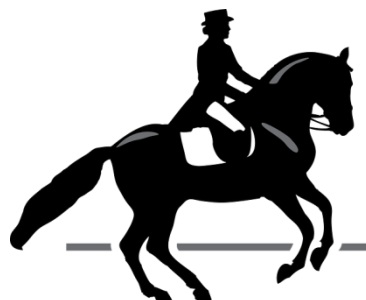
Herefordshire Primary Schools' Hardball Cricket Finals
