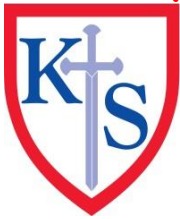
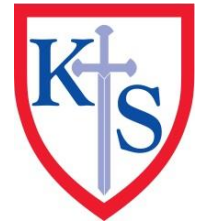

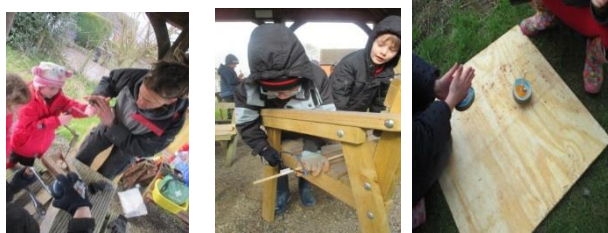
School Vacancy
