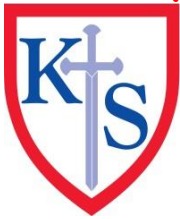
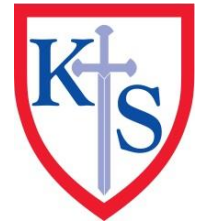

## Choir Events

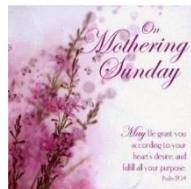


We are delighted to let you know about two exciting events in March in which our school choir will be taking part.
