We will be looking at non-fiction and fiction genres linked to our topic as well as *The Twits* by Roald Dahl to improve and develop:

- accurate use of punctuation and grammar
- learn and apply spelling rules and unusual spellings using *RWI Get Spelling* programme
- develop variety of sentence structures and use a varied, rich vocabulary in their writing
- research and set out non-fiction text

### Reading:

- fiction and non-fiction texts with fluency, good comprehension and love for reading and learning from the text

## Mathematics

- developing understanding of multiplication and division
- solving problems using multiplication and division facts they already know
- multiplying two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental methods and progressing to formal written methods
- fractions of shape and quantities
- measure including time and time problems

Focus on developing **KIRFS**: times tables 3s, 4s 8s and **mental arithmetic** and **reasoning** skills.
