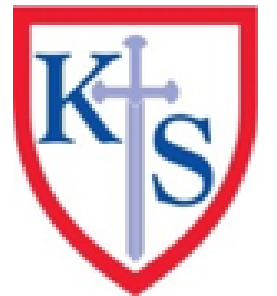

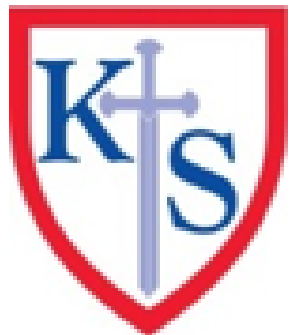
Routine

- Children to register in Class 2 or class 3
- Children are then collected and will be taught as a whole year group in the Victorian Classroom until lunchtime.
- After lunch they will remain in their class for foundation subjects.
- Except on a Friday afternoon where they will have golden time and PE together as a year group
- In the mornings they are taught by Mr Powell and supported by Miss Wills and Miss Davis



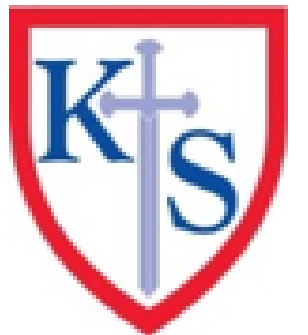
English

- During the mornings children will have a recap of their sounds knowledge.
- Then they will be taught a daily spelling rule. (There are lots in year 2)
- Followed by RWI – taught as a whole class.



Maths

- Children will take part in the Mastery number program.
- We follow the White Rose Scheme which is designed to progress in small steps.



Changing books

- Books are changed every week on a Tuesday.
 - In every reading record each child will have a reading table. Children will need to read each book three times every week.
 - The reason for this is to increase children's fluency.
 - We will only change the book when it has been read three times.

- When reading at home please ask your child lots of questions about the text.



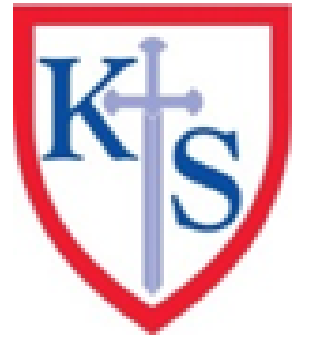
Home learning

- Home learning is sent out on a Thursday and is returned the following Tuesday.
- Home learning consists of:
- Spellings/grammar and punctuation
- Maths – a mental maths skill
- If children need any help with their home learning then I can help them on a Friday and Monday.
- There is also the Big 5 spelling which is 5 spellings sent out every week. This is slightly different as it is sent out on a Tuesday and returned the following Tuesday.
- Plus daily reading
- The key is – everything is in on a Tuesday!



Named items

- Please ensure the following items are named:
 - School clothing – particularly jumpers, cardigans and coats.
 - Drink bottles
 - Lunch boxes

- NB if children bring squash into school they will need another drink with water. We do not have squash in the classrooms, it can be drunk with their lunch. Only water is allowed in classrooms.
 - Even if there is small chance of rain please send your child in with a coat and we try to get the children outside as much as possible.



Bags

- Please no rucksack / bags in school – we really struggle for the space.
- When children arrive in school, books bags are put in boxes, lunch boxes are put on the shelf and drinks are put in trays in class. So there is no need for rucksack / bag.



PE Uniform

- Children will need to wear their PE uniforms on a Thursday and Friday as children in both Class 2 and 3 have PE on these days.
