

English

During the Summer term, Year 6 will be consolidating their learning for the first few weeks of the term in preparation for their SATs examinations and continuing with their Class novel, the London Eye Mystery. After this they will be creating a writing portfolio celebrating and perfecting their best pieces! Year 5 will be beginning their class novel, 'The Wolves in the Walls' before moving on to 'Clockwork' by Phillip Pullman.

Writing will take many forms including diaries, narratives, letters, information texts, poetry, journalistic writing and persuasion.

We shall focus on grammar, punctuation, writing and editing skills both in explicit lessons and throughout all lessons.

We shall continue to develop reading and comprehension strategies in class reading using a selection of different genres to engage and challenge. Spellings will follow the KS2 spelling National Curriculum guidelines.

We shall be using 'Philosophy for Children' (P4C) sessions to develop speaking and listening confidence and skills.

Mathematics

The mathematics curriculum covers the following mathematical concepts, to be taught during the academic year:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions (Decimals and Percentages)
- Ratio and Proportion
- Algebra
- Measurement
- Geometry - properties of shapes
- Geometry - position and direction
- Statistics

PE / Sport

Class 5 will be focusing on Rounders, Athletics and - when possible - some Tennis

History and Geography

We shall be tracking the development of the great Islamic city of Baghdad, including trading practice and everyday life and comparing it with contemporary cities in Western Europe. We will be learning about the spread of Islam through the Middle East and the legacy of and continuing influences of early Islam.

Religious Education

We shall be continuing with our enquiry:

'What do Christians believe Jesus did to save people?'

During the second half of the term, we will be exploring the enquiry:

'For Christians, what kind of King is Jesus?'

Science

Relationship and Sex Education pupils will take place this term [details to follow].

Studying Living Things and their Habitats, we will consider animal habitats quite practically - hopefully by going out to find some - which will lead us into learning about more formal classification of animals based on their similarities and differences.

We will learn about Light - how it travels, reflects, refracts and creates shadows

We will also include some revision of learning about Sound.

Computing

In Computing, we will be continuing to look at Computing systems and networks. We will also be learning about 3d modelling!

Music

Having learnt last term to identify the sounds of a wide range of instruments, we will listen to how many of them are used in a variety of famous pieces of music. We will also learn to sing a small number of quite challenging songs.

Art/DT

In Art, we will be exploring Islamic geometric art and using pattern, design and colour to create detailed and precise patterns of our own.
