

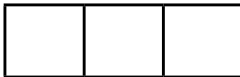


- 1) Colour the bar models to represent the fractions shown and then complete the statements converting the improper fractions into mixed numbers.

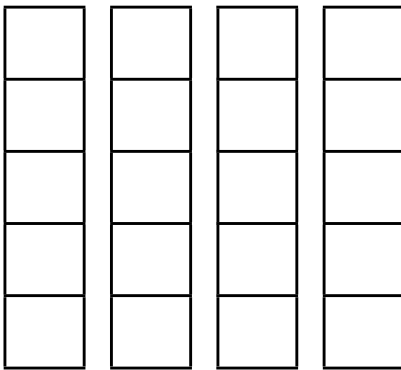
