

Class 4 English – Thursday 11th February 2021

Write non-chronological report about an endangered animal in neat.

Your task this morning is to write your draft non-chronological report in **neat**. This means that you need to use your neatest handwriting and present it as neatly as possible.

You will need to go to the **next double page** in your English book to do this work.

You should have:

- **5 paragraphs** to write (opening, appearance, diet, habitat and closing).
- **3 subheadings** that are underlined (Appearance, Diet, Habitat).
- A large and clear **title** (the name of your animal).
- At least 1 **picture/drawing** of your animal.

Your handwriting should be joined correctly and all lower-case letters should be the same height (like we've been working on in school) and 'tall letters' should be tall. Make sure there is a clear difference in height between capital letters and lower-case letters.

Make sure there are no 'random capital letters' in the middle of words or sentences where they shouldn't be.

Please do the writing before you start the large title and picture.

How you decorate your non-chronological report is up to you...make sure your work is still legible once you have finished.
