

Multiply 3 Digits by 1 Digit

1. A (840), C (936), B (1,518)
2. C. It is the odd one out because in is incorrect. $0 \times 3 = 0$, not 3. The answer should be 1,620.
3. No, the second multiplication is incorrect because the 15 (5×3) has been recorded wrongly in the answer. The 5 should be in the ones column in the answer and the 1 should be carried over to the tens column, to be added to the 24 (8×3). The answer should be 1,455.
