Task 2

Order these key events of Hajj, with 1 being the first and 8 being the last. One has been done for you.

Water is drunk from the Zamzam well.	
Muslims complete the Hajj by walking around the Ka'aba again, seven times.	
Muslims change their clothes for two white cloths and enter the state of Ihram.	
Muslims spend the night at Muzdalifa, a valley between Arafat and Mina.	
Pilgrims arrive at the Great Mosque and circle the Ka'aba seven times, which is called Tawaf.	
Muslims pray at Mount Arafat.	
Pilgrims visit the hills of Safa and Marwah and run between the two seven times.	
At Mina, they throw pebbles at three Jamarat (stone pillars).
