Jacqueline du Pré was a British cellist – she was regarded as one of the greatest cellists of all time. Her career was cut short by multiple sclerosis, which forced her to stop performing at the age of 28; she died 14 years later at the age of 42. Her Stradivarius cello was made in 1673, and is worth well over £1 million.
