

## **Year 2 Home learning**

**We have put together a whole range of different activities, worksheets and suggestions for your child to work through whilst at home. This is not an exclusive list nor are we suggesting that everything has to be completed. It is here as a means to support you in the coming weeks.**

**Reading** - Please can you READ READ READ. This is so important to continue your child's fluency of reading and please ask them lots of questions. Additional books have been sent home.

There are also a whole range of comprehension worksheets on the school website.

**English** – Included on the website are grammar activities and suggested writing tasks.

**Spelling** – There are a range of spelling worksheets on the school website plus there are the children's home learning books which have all the previously learnt spelling rules for practice.

**Maths** – On the website are a range of consolidation tasks for your child to practice. Also could you please practice times tables, particularly 10s, 5s, 2s and 3s. Again, in their home learning books are the previously learnt mental math skills as additional practice.

There are a few areas of maths which haven't been covered but we would like to ask you for your help.

These are to learn to tell the time on an analogue clock. First learn all the times by the hour, then half past and quarter past and then to 5 minutes. For example, 25 past 6 or 10 to 7.

Also could you please investigate measuring with a range of different units, such as metres and centimetre, kilograms and grams and millilitres and litres. This could be by measuring a pencil or a room with a ruler or tape measure or by measuring liquids and weights to make a cake.
