## **Class 1 Swimming – Summer term 2026**

The children in Class 1 will start swimming lessons this term as part of the PE National Curriculum provision at Leominster pool on the following dates:-

- Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May, Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> May,
- **No swimming on 4<sup>th</sup> June – Sports Day**
- Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June, Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June, Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June
- Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July

Children will swim from 1.30 to 2.30pm.

This letter will be uploaded to our website so that you can refer to it for dates etc.

We are delighted to have secured a one hour booking each week. This allows the school three advantages:

- Increased overall swimming lesson time
- Increased curriculum time for other curriculum areas
- Reduced travel costs

The cost will be £42.00 for **7 sessions** to be paid by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May please. Payment can be made online via the Arbor system. Please navigate to the *Clubs* section, select *Swimming*, register your child, and follow the steps provided. (Please note there are not 8 sessions as stated on Arbor due to Sports Day on 4<sup>th</sup> June. There is no facility to skip a week on Arbor)! If there are any issues making payment or accessing the online consent form, please do not hesitate to contact us. Please tick the consent box on Arbor and provide further information regarding your child's swimming ability using this link [Swimming Class 1 Summer 2026 – Fill out form](#) If school or the swimming pool have to cancel the session, then you will be reimbursed.

In line with the DfE guidance and the school's policy, we ask for voluntary contributions for swimming lessons, to cover the cost of pool hire, transport and instructors. The PTA are making a contribution to keep the transport costs as low as possible. These contributions allow the school to provide further extended opportunities, such as our fantastic upcoming iSingPop project. If costs cannot be covered, then swimming provision and other activities might need to be altered or cancelled.

Over the last couple of years, the school has carefully reviewed the swimming provision resulting in multiple benefits, including greater overall swimming time and reduced transport costs. We have also looked into other providers, which have all quoted higher costs than what is being charged currently. If parents are experiencing financial hardship, we do encourage them to speak to us in confidence.

Please note that children are not allowed to enter the pool wearing jewellery of any kind and long hair should be tied back. **Swimming hats must be worn for school lessons** at Leominster Leisure Pool. Goggles need to be of a good standard, correctly fitted for your child and water-tight! Please help your child to practice getting goggles on/off independently and adjusting them to the correct size.
